



TOWN OF SALISBURY  
SELECTMENS' MEETING  
Monday, January 4, 2010

Present: Curtis Rand, Bob Riva, Jim Dresser, Heather Bartram, Brian Bartram, members of the press and public

Mr. Rand called the meeting to order at 4pm.

Mr. Dresser made a motion to approve the agenda with an addition of rescheduling of the February Selectmen's meeting date from February 1st to February 8th. Mr. Riva seconded the motion and the agenda was approved.

Mr. Dresser made a motion to approve the minutes of the Selectmen's meeting of December 7, 2009. Mr. Riva seconded and the motion was approved.

Old Business:

Mr. Rand stated that the Registrars of Voters were in agreement with a proposal from the Secretary of State to change the term of their appointments from 2 to 4 years. A final determination on this matter will be made at a future date.

Mr. Dresser made a motion to appoint Mr. Riva for a 1 year term to the Citizens Advisory Council for Cable T.V, and as a Alternate for the Northwest Council of Governments for a 1 year term. Mr. Rand seconded and the motion was approved.

New Business:

Mr. Rand stated that the contract with Connecticut Resource Recovery Authority (CRRRA) will expire in 2012. Members of Transfer Station Recycling Advisory Committee (TRAC) and Salisbury Shoron Resource Recovery Authority (SSRRA) will be challenged to look for economically viable ways to dispose of solid waste and recyclables through CRRRA and any other outlets, both in-state and out-of-state.

Mr. Bartram stated that he will make a presentation at the January 6, 2010 NWCOG meeting in Goshen. The Selectmen and Mr. Bartram mentioned that CRRRA plans to offer new 5-year contracts to member towns, and that details will be forthcoming in the late winter and spring.
